Preparation of the Documents for Applying to the Host Institution

1. The students who have been selected for the exchange should prepare additional documents as required by the designated host institution. They should submit all the application documents required to the OIA, and the OIA will subsequently forward them to the host institution. Late submission will not be accepted, so the students should carefully note the designated host institution's application deadline. (Note: It may take 7-10 work days for overseas delivery).

2. In their selection process, the designated host institutions may require additional documents, other than the items originally listed. The students must strictly comply with these requirements. The application review generally takes 2 to 4 months. The OIA will inform the students of the results when they are released.

3. The students should not make any travel arrangement prior to receiving an official admission letter from the designated host institution, to ensure that they are officially admitted as exchange students.
