new skills in order for youth to engage in social change and achievement of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

In recent years, United Nations is calling for member states to equip young people with the skills and technology required now and anticipate future needs through strong education and training systems in order to amplify youth voice, support and empower youth participation in public life and organizations, and keep up with technological change and engage in achievement of SDGs. For example, António Guterres, UN Secretary-General stressed, "the United Nations must empower young people, increase their participation in society and their access to education, training and jobs." Thus, GYLA endeavors to promote and participate in the UN Geographic Diversity Strategy & Action Plan through outreach activities (online and offline programs) in order to attract more multitalented young people from developing countries and LDCs to join the UN workforce in the future.

The purpose of GYLA is to inspire and empower youth as future global leaders, social & green entrepreneurs for social change and engagement in achievement of the

UN 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. GYLA works on many different levels to achieve positive social change and SDGs – including advocacy, research, innovative learning & training programs, and social & green business start-up projects. GYLA is a unique youth-led





platform where young people can dialogue with and learn from global successful leaders, practitioners and professionals from the UN agencies, academic institutions and enterprises; it is a cradle where young people can be nurtured

to grow and become future leaders, and it also aims to unleash young people's inner sources of new growth potential and achieve new levels of personal fulfilment in their career development in international community.

GYLA: In Support of SDGs

Since she was founded six years ago, GYLA has shared the purpose and vision of the United Nations on youth development and youth engagement, which are cross-

cutting issues in the UN 2030 Agenda. GYLA finds herself an intrinsic link to United Nations. GYLA was created at a historical juncture as the 2030 Agenda was adopted in 2015, and the UN 2030 Youth Strategy was developed in 2017. The purpose and values of GYLA are in alignment with the UN's mission on youth development that

GYLA was born for empowering young people as future leaders to engage in the movement of social change, because she is aware that the active engagement of youth in sustainable development efforts is central to achieving sustainable, inclusive and stable societies by the target date, and to averting the worst threats and challenges to sustainable development. As the United Nations turned 75 in 2020, and with only 10 years remaining to make the 2030 Agenda a reality for all, it is very important for institutions at the local, national and global levels to engage young people in global action for SDGs.

GYLA is also a powerful knowledge sharing and learning platform where young people are equipped with frontier knowledge and new technology, and empowered to become systems thinkers, change makers, social innovators, green entrepreneurs and future leaders for a better world.

For this purpose, GYLA endeavors to be a leader in working with young people: in understanding their needs, in helping to put their ideas into action. In so doing, GYLA integrates SDGs and UN 2030 Youth Strategy in her curricula and activities to empower young people to realize their full potential and to stand up for their rights, and to engage themselves in the efforts to contribute to achievement of SDGs.

GYLA Philosophy: Of the Youth, by the Youth and for the Youth

GYLA is youth-led program embodying the philosophy of "GYLA of the youth, by the youth, and for the youth". In times of pandemic crisis, GYLA has played a more important role in supporting and amplifying youth voices and actions by boosting the quality and delivery of different programs and activities, and outreaching and helping more young people to mitigate the negative impact, particularly in the developing countries.

GYLA of the Youth

GYLA is a unique platform built for young people to learn from global successful leaders, and exchange information and knowledge with their peers. Young people are

encouraged to take ownership of GYLA, in other words, to take the initiative to bring about positive impact of GYLA on the community and society as a whole. Taking ownership means caring about and improving the quality and outcome of GYLA program much as an owner of GYLA. When they take ownership, young



people are able to show others that they can trust them to do the right things right. GYLA's core values are at the heart of creating an environment where young people feel empowered to act and bring about social change. GYLA *of the youth* is to nurture a culture that fosters and values ownership. Young people have an obligation to GYLA in terms of results and to act on the GYLA programs that impact those results. Young people are also empowered to be accountable for their own results of their actions.

GYLA by the Youth

Young people are the owners of GYLA, therefore, they have the right and power to govern and manage GYLA, and are responsible for the quality and future of GYLA growth. Since the foundation, GYLA program has been managed, organized, implemented and evaluated by the GYLA dream team and GYLAers. GYLA dream team is the leader of overall GYLA operations. It consists of three sub-teams respectively responsible for social medial, multimedia design & production, and news & reporting. The members of the dream team are recruited from the outstanding GYLAers who graduated from GYLA activities. They are talented and highly qualified with good character, and humble to serve others. What's more, dream team also encourages and involves participants to work for GYLA during the implementation of activities.

GYLA for the Youth

The mission of GYLA is to inspire youth to dream more, learn more, do more, achieve more, and become more. Young people have the creativity, potential and capacity to make change happen – for themselves, for their communities, and for the rest of the world. GYLA is also a dreamer like the youth, therefore, GYLA can promise youth to be the guiding light of the youth, and the stepping stone of the youth, to realize the dreams and goals. Goals give purpose, purpose gives faith, faith gives courage, courage gives enthusiasm, enthusiasm gives energy, energy gives life, and life lifts youth over the bar. The ambitious goal of GYLA is to engage with millions of young people, particularly in impoverished areas and lower-income countries, to create change through participation in different types of learning programs and social events that GYLA will organize, build solid youth networks, reach young people to work on peacebuilding and sustainable development, and is committed to empowering underprivileged youth by providing them with spaces to participate by offering them with various accessible resources and activities.

GYLA Impact



Since 2016, GYLA has organized 7 editions of offline and online learning programs, over 1300 outstanding college students from about 50 top universities around the world have participated in the activities. Many of the outstanding participants have successfully worked as interns and volunteers in the United Nations agencies; some have been recommended to continue studying in the well-known universities in the world; some have found jobs in the multinational companies, and some have started up their own social & green enterprises.
