THE UIA WORLD CONGRESS OF ARCHITECTS CPH 2023

The UIA World Congress of Architects in Copenhagen 2023 is the world's largest event on Sustainable Architecture. And the whole built environment is invited!

The World Congress is held every three years in different countries and will be hosted in 2023 for the first time in Copenhagen, Denmark by the UIA Nordic section: Denmark, Finland, Faroe Islands, Iceland, Norway and Sweden. The International Union of Architects <u>UIA</u> was founded in 1948 and unites national architect associations in more than 100 countries.

SUSTAINABLE FUTURES - LEAVE NO ONE BEHIND

Our goal next year is to promote, discuss, create and showcase architecture as a vital tool to achieve the UN 17 Sustainable Development Goals. We will share sustainable solutions, examine the latest research results and join our efforts to make the 28th UIA World Congress a milestone in the history of what architecture can do to help save the planet. In this sense, the UIA World Congress of Architects in 2023 has already begun, and you are invited to join us in Copenhagen July 2-6 2023.

We focus on involving students from Architecture, Landscape Architecture, Construction Management, Human-centered Design, Urban Planning and Development, Sustainability, Environmental Planning, Construction, Building, Innovation, Change Management, Universal Design, Biodiversity, Sustainable Transition, Strategic Design and Entrepreneurship.

Pre - Events

HOW TO HOST A PRE-EVENT AT YOUR SCHOOL OR COMMUNITY

We encourage you to host a local pre-event. The pre-event can be a talk, debate, exhibition, performance, presentation, workshop or something else.

All you have to do is to make sure you can tick off the following bullets:

- The event is leading up to the congress by focusing on either the main theme "Sustainable Futures - Leave No One Behind" or one of the six congress themes: Design for Health, Design for Inclusivity, Design for Rethinking Resources, Design for Climate Change, Design for Resilient Communities or Design for Partnerships for Change. - The event is open and accessible for all to participate in either physical or digital (or both) - It's okay to have limited seats.
- The event is as sustainable as possible in terms of materials, catering etc.
- The event details are communicated in English. The event can take place in other languages than English. If so it should be explained in the description.
- The event contributes to the realization of the congress' goals and the SDGs.

All expenses for planning and hosting the event are yours.

SUMMER ACADEMY



HOW TO MAKE A SIDE EVENT

All friends of the congress are invited to contribute with proposals for events and activities which will happen during the conference, but outside the Bella Center venue and outside congress hours.

A side event can be many things – a tour, talk or site visit. A debate or roundtable, a reception, dinner, picnic or community singing. Side events will be branded with the congress' logo and communicated under the headline Side Events in the programme, website, app etc.

The title of the world congress is "Sustainable Futures – Leave no one behind". Therefore, organizers should incorporate sustainability, inclusion, and accessibility in all aspects of the event.

Hosting a side event means planning, carrying out and paying for all activities related to the event. Deadline for side event submission is March 1st, 2023.
