



The Faculty of Agriculture is one of three founding faculties of Universiti Pertanian Malaysia (now known as Universiti Putra Malaysia) in 1971. The faculty began with seven (7) departments and has become the basis for the establishment of several other faculties in the development process by developing the department to become an independent faculty. The restructuring exercise at the Universiti Putra Malaysia which began on January 1, 1999, also involved the Faculty of Agriculture.

The restructuring exercise at the faculty was based on the concept of unification or integration of the key elements in the agricultural system namely crops, soil, livestock, agribusiness, technology, and fisheries. Based on this concept, the Faculty of Agriculture now comprises seven (7) departments, namely (1) the Department of Crop Science, (2) the Department of Plant Protection, (3) the Department of Land Management, (4) Department of Animal Science, (5) Department of Agribusiness and Biosource Economics. (6)Department of Agricultural Technology and (7) Department of Aquaculture.

Along with the national education goals, the Faculty of Agriculture always strives to produce trained agricultural experts, entrepreneurial characteristics and able to conduct consultations to the community to ensure the sustainability of agriculture, while creating new agricultural technology, as a result of quality program structure, research spirit and commercialization of agricultural products.


