Afternoon session	<p><b>Welcome Reception</b> by Representatives of the City of Nürnberg ***</p> <p><b>Guided City Tour Nürnberg to the Historical City Centre of Nürnberg</b></p> <p><i>A pleasant walking tour through the Old Town offers information on the castle, the fountains, wells, Nürnberg's city churches and art treasures as well as a flavour about the city's colourful past and cosmopolitan present.</i></p> <p><a href="https://tourismus.nuernberg.de/en/">https://tourismus.nuernberg.de/en/</a></p> <p>or</p> <p><b>Guided Tour Art Bunker</b></p> <p><i>The guided tours to this bunker installation, which is without parallel in Germany, focus on protecting art from air raids, the near-complete destruction of Nürnberg in World War II, and rebuilding the ruined city.</i></p> <p><i>The city's most important art treasures, like Veit Stoss's "Annunciation" from the Lorenzkirche or the Imperial Regalia, survived the war's heavy air raids by taking shelter deep in the bedrock of Castle Hill.</i></p> <p><i>A large portion of the Art Bunker's original structures can still be seen today.
