

Chulalongkorn University has been ranked, by THE Impact Rankings 2023, No.1 in Thailand for four consecutive years and top 17 in the world. There are the first global performance rankings that assess universities against the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals, taking into consideration the role played by the university in term of research generated, administration, academic services and education provided.

Three other academic institutions in Thailand have also been placed in the top 100 – Mahidol University at 38, Chiang Mai University at 74 and Khon Kaen University at 97.

1,591 universities from 112 countries have taken part in THE Impact Rankings 2023 including 65 Thai universities whose number has increased from 52 in 2022 to 65 in 2023. Chulalongkorn University has made it to the world's top 100 in the following 9 areas;


