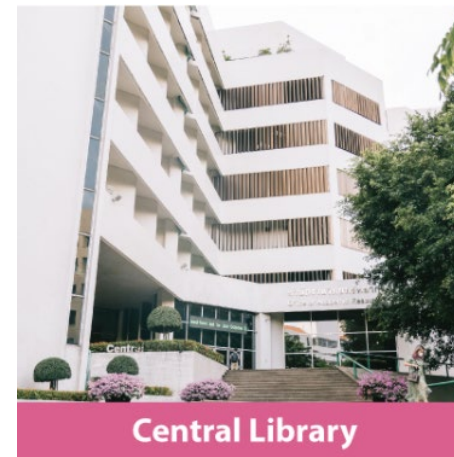

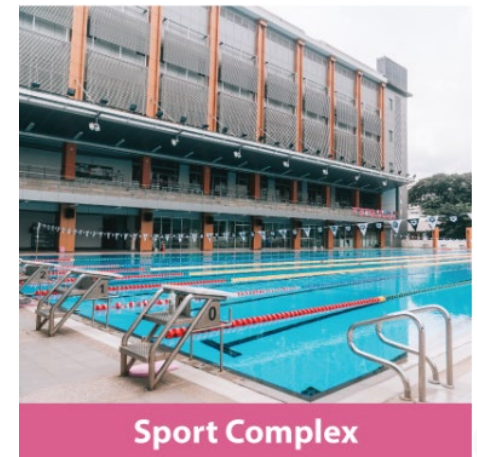

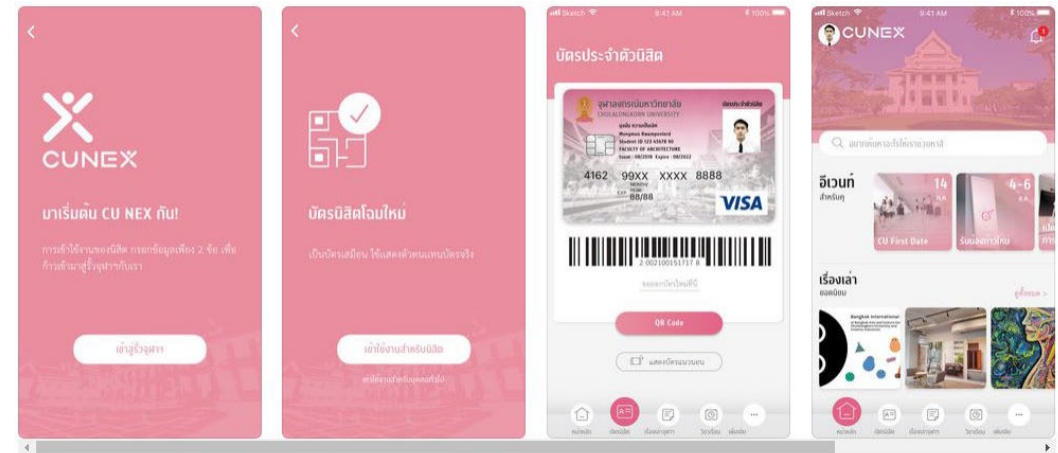

How to request CU Student ID Card

Preparation Steps

1. Download the mobile CU NEX application
IOS version : <https://apple.co/2skrPrV> or
Android version : <http://bit.ly/2LSu0Qn>
2. Check your Student Registration Result via
<https://www.reg.chula.ac.th/newstudentsen.html>
Both photo and passport must be successfully uploaded.
3. Open a Kasikorn Bank account under your name and
download K PLUS application.
4. Complete your Course Registration and your Tuition Fee
Payment via CU NEX application

How to request CU Student ID Card

Debit Card

- (1) Open CU NEX and select 'Digital ID'
- (2) Select 'Request a new card'
- (3) The system will direct you to K PLUS to allow for an access to link with CU NEX
- (4) Select the bank account to be linked to your student ID card
- (5) Select your delivery location
 - ① Delivery to your address or
 - ② Collect from K Bank branch
- (6) Select 'confirm' and wait for your student ID to arrive.

Non-debit Card

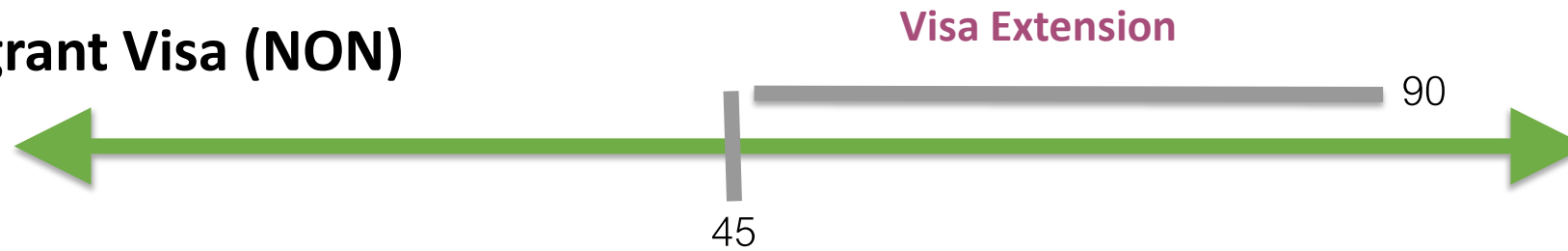
- (1) Inform your program coordinator that you would like to request for a non-debit card and ask your faculty/program coordinator to send a memo to Office of Registrar.
- (2) Your faculty/program send a request memo to Office of Registrar
- (3) Office of Registrar verify the completion of your student registration.
- (4) Office of Registrar will issue a non-debit ID card.
- (5) Pick up you non-debit ID card at Office of the Registrar at Chamchuri 6 Building

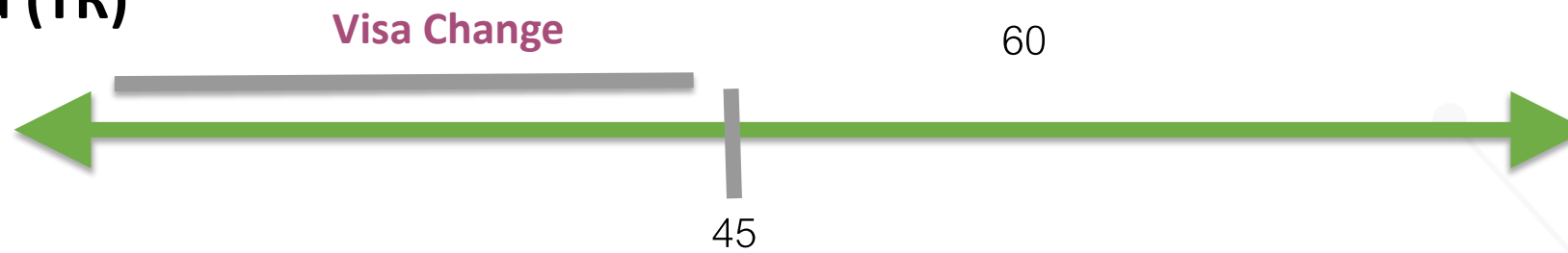

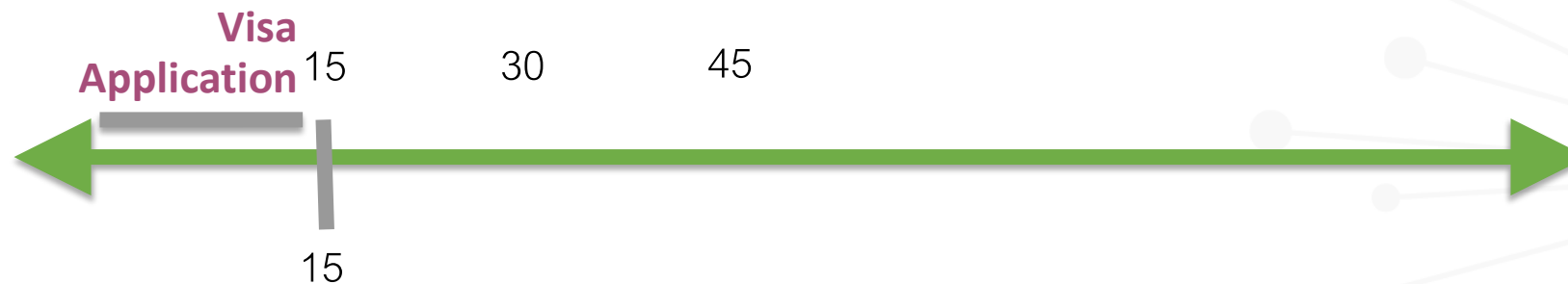




VISA – 90 days Notification

Accident insurance for international students



Chula has provided accident insurance for all undergraduate, master's, and doctoral students who have registered through the university's registration office.

The coverage amounts are as follows:

General accidents: 40,000 baht

Accidents within the university or university activities: 50,000 baht


