








VISA – Type of Entry






VISA - 90 days Notification





The notification must be made within 15 days before or after 7 days the period of 90 days expires.


- Submit form in person or by authorized person at Immigration Office @The Government Complex, Chaeng Wattana Road

VISA - Re-Entry Permit




















Benefits

Exempted from Re-Entry Permit

During the course of study, foreign students in bachelor degree level or higher can depart and re-enter Thailand without the need for a re-entry permit.

Extensions of Stays

Universities/Institutions will submit the visa extension application on behalf of the students.

Extended Stay for Graduated Student

Foreign students are allowed to extend the stay in Thailand for 1 year after graduating, to seek employment, travel or participate in other activities and are eligible to apply for new type of visa in Thailand if employed.



NON-ED Plus VISA



Who can apply for ED Plus VISA

- 1) For current degree seeking student, who arrive Thailand or apply for visa extension after July 15, 2024 onwards, the immigration staff will permit the ED Plus Visa automatically.
- 2) For graduating degree seeking student, who wish to stay in Thailand up to 1 year after graduate to find a job in Thailand.







Chula has provided accident insurance for all undergraduate, master's, and doctoral students who have registered through the university's registration office.

The coverage amounts are as follows:

General accidents: 40,000 baht

Accidents within the university or university activities: 50,000 baht


