- University (undergraduate and graduate) students from Korea, Vietnam, Laos, Cambodia, Thailand, Myanmar) (including those on leave of absence)

- A valid passport is required

- Individuals with an understanding of the purpose and goals of the ROK-Mekong Youth Group Workshop interested in multilateral cooperation and exchange

- Passionate individuals with fluent English communication skills who aspire to become next-generation global leaders

- Optional: Recommendation letter from university or department head
