JOB DESCRIPTION & ELIGIBILITY

The Asia Pacific Center for Theoretical Physics (APCTP) invites applications for the Young Scientist Training (YST) Fellowship. This position is intended for early-career researchers in theoretical physics who have demonstrated research ability.

- **Eligibility:** Applicants from all fields of theoretical physics are welcome.
- **Environment:** The fellowship provides opportunities to interact and collaborate with APCTP in-house researchers, POSTECH faculty, visiting scholars, and participants in APCTP-supported scientific programs.

Requirements for Application

- Applicants must hold an official doctoral degree (PhD, DSc, or equivalent) at least three months prior to the start date.
 - The degree certificate must be issued and sealed by the awarding institution.
 - Certificates of expected graduation, or supporting letters are not accepted.

REMUNERATION & BENEFITS

- **Annual gross salary:** Starting from **KRW 36,000,000**
- **Research funding:**
 - **KRW 5,000,000 per year** for other research activities.
- **Housing support:** A shared house will be provided for up to one month upon arrival to assist with accommodation while you search for permanent housing.
- **One-way airfare to APCTP will be provided**
- **Contract term: 2+1 years** (renewable for a third year depending on research performance and availability of resources for the program)
