Eligibility

- Applicants must be **currently enrolled in a recognized university-level institution** at the time of application.
- Applicants who wish to enroll in **English-taught academic courses** are required to submit **proof of English proficiency**. Accepted tests and minimum scores include: TOEFL iBT 80, IELTS 6.0, TOEIC 880 or above, Duolingo English Test 110, or other equivalent certifications approved by the NCCU ISS Team.

- A copy of your **passport**
- A **certificate of enrollment** from your current university
- **Proof of English proficiency**, if applicable (for non-native English speakers)

Accommodation

Accommodation for NCCU ISS participants is arranged at **NCCU International House (NCCU-iHouse)**, a seven-story residence located just a five-minute walk from NCCU's main gate.
