- This program is open to students from **all majors**, with a strong interest in urban development, or sustainable design.
- Applicants must be university students aged 18 or above.
- Applicants should possess **basic English proficiency**, as the program will be conducted in English.

Visa Reminder – Hong Kong

- Nationals from about 170 countries and regions are eligible for visa-free entry into Hong Kong for 7–180 days (depending on nationality). Please confirm the requirements based on your passport.
- If a visa is required, allow sufficient time for the application process.
- Participants unable to obtain a Hong Kong visa may stay in Shenzhen during the Hong Kong field trip. Please note: no partial refund will be provided for missed portions of the program.
